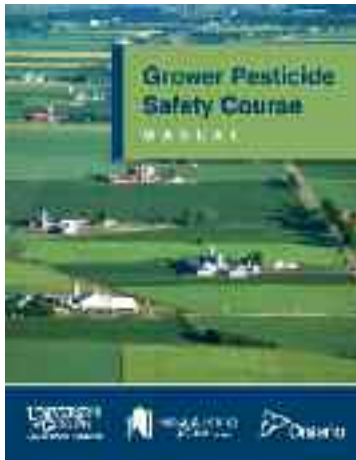

ANIMAL FEED & NUTRITION

The 5 C's of Calf Raising

- Good Quality Colostrum : Min 4 liters immediately after birth (or alternatively splitting between 2 feedings within the 1st 12-hours with smaller breeds)
- Good quality free choice warm water after milk feeding.



- Temp of milk or water/milk replacer solution should be 100-105°F
- Wean when calf is eating 1kg calf starter per day for several days.
- Hay & grain after weaning off milk (no fermented feed till 6 months of age)..
- Removing calf from calving pen ASAP. He suggested if you want the dam to lick off calf you should place the newborn in a disinfected empty poly water trough.
- Stressed cleanliness when working with calves E. coli bacteria doubles every 20 min @ 60°F
- Dipping navel before Dam licks calf off and after.

The 5 C's are **Comfort, Cleanliness, Consistency, Calories** and **Colostrum**
