It's time to start planning for preharvest burndown in your wheat. It is the best time to control those tough perennial weeds like dandelion and Canada thistle. A preharvest application also helps with harvest ease.

The correct timing for wheat is when the crop is 30% moisture or less, also known as hard dough stage. A quick way to test this is the thumbnail test. If you push your thumbnail into the kernel and the imprint stays, the crop is ready for herbicide.

Be sure to talk to your crop specialist for more information.

## ANIMAL FEED & NUTRITION

I'm happy to report that to date we have 9 herds that consist of 173 heifers that have been weighed and measured and are currently on the Ampli-calf program. We are seeing on average a 2.5 lb of weight gain per day across the board along with a 1 in. of hip height growth per 10-day period on our second measurements. Calves are long, lean and tall to the eye and have us and our producers excited about their future development. Our goal here is to get them to 600lbs and 48in. at 6 months and most of these calves should reach this with ease. We are also seeing some outstanding individuals that depending where they are in the program are breaking the 3 lbs per day and 1.25 in. per 10-day period.



Quintecrest Reginald Grady

Our feature Ampli-calf is Quintecrest Reginald Grady who is gaining at 2.7lbs per day and growing at a 1.4 inches every 10-day clip. Well done Grady and Jean!!

Remember the first 6 months of your heifer calfs life will determine the Girl that is producing for you later and research has shown they will produce more milk !

If you are interested in doing an Ampli-calf trial don't hesitate to get in touch with me and we can start your program with a weigh in.
